Michael E. Matczak was born June 17, 1937 in Detroit and passed away September 23, 2018. He attended Assumption Grotto Catholic School and graduated from Denby High School in 1957. He went on to serve in the U.S. Army and in 1966 he founded M.E.M. Construction and Contracting, retiring in 1998 to his home in Hume Township, Huron County, Michigan. He spent time working around his retirement home, The Pinnebog Ranch where "life doesn't get any better than this." Michael enjoyed hunting and spending time with his six grandsons and was their #1 fan at the Clarkston Chiefs, Notre Dame Prep Fighting Irish and the Caseville Eagles. He enjoyed smoking fish, wintering in Naples, Florida and making new friends wherever he went.

His children, Alyse Kozfkay and Mark Matczak created the Michael E. Matczak Foundation to advance the educational opportunities for Huron County student athletes who need financial assistance for college and have demonstrated good sportsmanship and upstanding moral character, participated in extra-curricular activities at school and in their community, and has earned proficient grades.

The foundations goal is to award educational grant money each year to a student from North Huron, Laker and Caseville High School. This will be accomplished through the generosity of good people who shared Michael's values and character.

An annual Michael E. Matczak Foundation golf outing is held, along with raffles and contests to help fund the endeavors of the foundation. This year, we are proud to present \$3,000.00 scholarships to a North Huron and Laker student and \$6,000.00 to a Caseville student. Mike enjoyed the years that his grandchildren attended Caseville and was a big supporter of the school, music department, and sports program.
